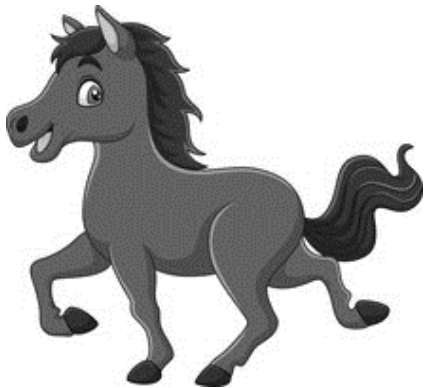

RULES OF THE SHOW

1. The committee reserves the right of refusing any entry, cancelling or altering the classes and arrangement of the program, or of postponing the show in the event of any unfavourable or unforeseen circumstances.
2. The committee will not be responsible for any accident arising from any cause connected with the show and it shall be a condition of entry that each competitor shall hold the committee blameless and indemnify them against legal proceedings.
3. Any Exhibitor lodging a protest must first deposit £5 with the Secretary which will be forfeited to the funds if same is not sustained. All protests must be in writing and received within one hour of the class. The decision of the committee will be final.
4. The committee reserves the right to establish the correct height of any horse and to allow half-an-inch for shoes.
5. Prize money must be collected on the day of the show. Prize money will be forfeited if entries are removed before 4:30.
6. The Committee reserve the right to cancel any class of less than three entries. The judges may withhold any prize for insufficient merit. Entry fees will be refunded in such cases.
7. No entries accepted after judging begins
8. Riding hats must be worn in every event and when mounted.
9. Prove of age must be shown on request.

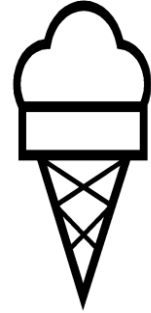
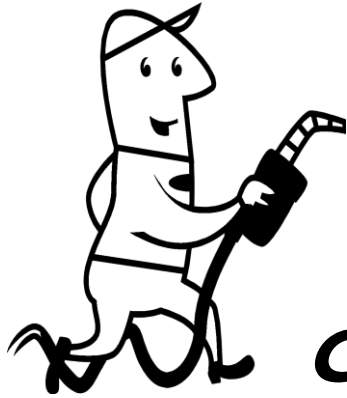
